

## **PB-507 Installation Procedure for Windows Drivers**

Many contemporary devices ship with unsigned drivers, which could pose problems with running specific operating systems. The Driver Signature Enforcement in Windows 7 (64-bit), 8, and 10 specifically blocks the drivers that come with the PB-507 trainer. You will need to temporarily disable this security feature to allow proper installation of the drivers to be able to use these products. **NOTE: This is only a temporary bypass of an important security feature. When you reboot your computer, the security features will automatically be reinstated.**

To temporarily disable the Driver Signature Enforcement feature:

1. Open the Run box by pressing **WIN+R**.
2. Type **shutdown /r /o** and select **OK**.
3. Windows warns that you are about to be signed off. Select **Close**. The computer will automatically reboot.
4. Once computer has rebooted, select **Troubleshoot**.
5. Select **Advanced options**.
6. Select **Startup Settings**.
7. Select **Restart** to reboot computer.
8. After reboot, in Startup Settings windows, press **F7** to select **Disable driver signature enforcement**.
9. Computer will then reboot. Proceed to install unsigned drivers by right clicking on the driver files and selecting **install**. During the installation procedure, Windows will inform you that it cannot verify the publisher of this driver software. Select **Install this driver software anyway** to complete the installation.

After the next restart, Driver Signature Enforcement will be automatically enabled again to prevent new drivers from being installed, but Windows will keep any unsigned drivers that have already been installed.
