Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Compliance

Cal Test Electronics, Inc. is committed, through its Quality Policy, to reducing or eliminating hazardous substances in its test and measurement products and to promoting environmentally responsible recycling and reuse practices.

Cal Test Electronics, Inc. declares that its products comply with the requirements of the European Union **Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) Directive 2011/65/EU**, as amended by Directive **(EU) 2015/863**, and any subsequent applicable amendments.

The RoHS Directive restricts the use of the following substances in electrical and electronic equipment:

- *Lead (pb) : 0.1% **
- *Mercury (Hg) : 0.1%*
- *Cadmium (Cd) : 0.01%*
- *Hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) : 0.1%*
- *Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) : 0.1%*
- *Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) : 0.1%*
- *Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP) : 0.1%*
- *Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP) : 0.1%*
- *Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) : 0.1%*
- *Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) : 0.1%*

*Maximum concentration values tolerated by weight in homogeneous materials.

Applicable exemptions under the RoHS Directive are applied where permitted.

Cal Test Electronics, Inc. classifies its products under **Category 9**: Monitoring and Control Instruments, including industrial monitoring and control instruments.

Cal Test Electronics, Inc. works closely with its global supply chain partners to ensure ongoing compliance with these requirements. All new products are designed to meet RoHS requirements at the time of introduction.
